* A 17.5% tuition discount applies to the sibling in the lower grade.

- Delinquent accounts:** Students with accounts overdue by 30 days will be subject to non-admittance to school until the balance is settled.
- Proration:** School fees are based on 180 instructional days. No proration is provided for absences, school breaks, or holidays. Tuition for late enrollment is prorated based on the annual tuition of the selected payment plan and remaining instructional days, and billed over the remaining months through May.
- Due Dates and Late fee:** One-Payment due August 1, 2025. Two-Payment due August 1, 2025 and January 1, 2026. Installments due on the 1st of each month from August through May. A late fee applies to payments more than five (5) calendar days past due.
- Student Withdrawals :** A 60-day written notice is required. Tuition remains due for the notice period regardless of attendance. Records are released once the account is paid in full.
- Referral Credit:** Referrals of full-paying students qualify for a \$500 credit; reduced credits apply for incentivized tuition. The referrer must be named on the enrollment paperwork. Credit is issued after the student completes 60 days of enrollment and remains current on payments..
